3. GOING LIVE SOON: Application for new Palmer Grant Cycle, up to \$25K - New!

This year's cycle theme is "Turning Tables and Building Bridges: *Being* Good News for All God's People." Application period runs from Thursday, June 15 through Monday, July 31, 2017.

- Palmer Grants provide support for regions and churches willing to experiment and labor toward a vision of what the church can be when people of God live into the disciple-call to be the hands and feet of Christ, demonstrating the unifying power of the Spirit of love. This year's cycle is co-sponsored by the Multi-Region Corp, of which ABC/Wisconsin is a member.
- We are seeking to support projects from those who will take a serious look at current Christian practices within their ministry contexts, incorporate one or more of the seven ministry priorities identified at the ABC Mission Table, and propose innovative and collaborative ways "to be good news" across old and newly-experienced divisions and barriers.
 - A close look at Jesus' ministry on earth reveals a consistent probing and critique of the then-current understanding and application of the values and teachings of the faith. Jesus challenged his listeners to self-reflection and then pointed them toward God and new ways of living—adjusting their perspectives not only on matters of faith but also of other people. [The cleansing of the temple in Mark 11:15 is only one such example in which he corrected a distortion of the activities of the church and called the people to be "a house of prayer for all nations."]
 - The landscape in which we minister today is constantly and quickly evolving in many directions, with sometimes hopeful and other times disheartening impact. This reality provides great and urgent opportunities for us to be—or incarnate—the good news of Christ. The current seven mission priorities identified by American Baptists throughout our denomination invite us to break out of our comfortable norms and be an intentional and transformative presence regarding these current challenges.
 - Through this grant cycle the Multi-Region Corporation and the American Baptist Foundation desire to promote projects that:
 - propose a relevant application of the Christian faith in ways that equip people of faith to be the hands and feet of Christ in their society
 - are informed by any of the seven ABC mission priorities
 - that demonstrate an effort by the applying organization to overcome divisions or barriers and build bridges with others
 - are developed in conversation with the related ABC regional entity and will advance the mission of that ABC region

4. Summer Wellness Challenge 2017 - Starting Soon! - New!

"Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well." 3 John 1:2 (NIV)

- Is there some part of your life you have wanted to improve or change or something new you have wanted to try? If so, the Summer of 2017 is the time to do it!
- Starting Wednesday, June 21st we will be kicking off a 90-day summer wellness challenge initiative, divided into three 30-day intervals, during which you can set a goal focused on your mind, body, and/or soul, and as a group we will help you achieve it!
- How will we do this?
 - There will be two groups: Team Lake vs Team River
 - Join one group doesn't matter which one, just let the challenge leader know what your goal is.
 - Some ideas may be: Get more or better sleep, drink more water (75oz/day), run a 5K, write a personal letter 2X/week, do 30 push-ups, have contemplative prayer each day...
 - Details on goal setting will be given before each 30-day interval.
 - Each team will earn points every week based on mini-challenges or updated information on how progress is coming on their goals; the team with the most points will earn bragging rights in the Region!
- Data shows that having and writing down a specific goal plus having accountability partners increases your chance of success.
